DEAR PATRONS,

This pandemic has decimated jobs and placed masses of livelihoods at risk. Millions of workers – waged and self-employed, regularly face high levels of working poverty, malnutrition and poor health, and suffer from a lack of safety and labour protection. With low and irregular incomes and a lack of social support, many of them are spurred to continue working, often in unsafe conditions, thus exposing themselves and their families to additional risks. Migrant workers are particularly vulnerable, because they face risks in their transport, working and living conditions and struggle to access support measures put in place by governments.

Ashray Akruti's Covid Relief Service Team worked ceaselessly to deliver essentials like food and medical assistance to the vulnerable families in the community. On the ground, we are mobilizing substantial local relief efforts in the communities where we operate.

Gratitude to all those generous donors, is being expressed by Ashray Akruti for their thoughtful contribution, which has enabled our team to touch the lives of defenseless & needy families and to provide the requisite medical help, grocery kits and medical reimbursements.

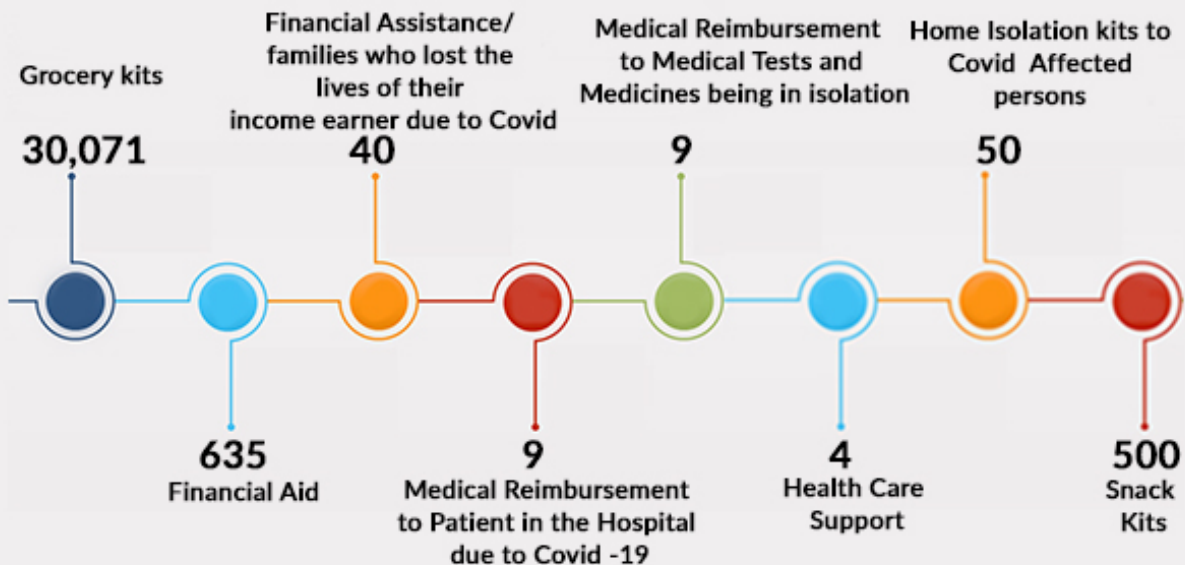


REACHING THE UNREACHED

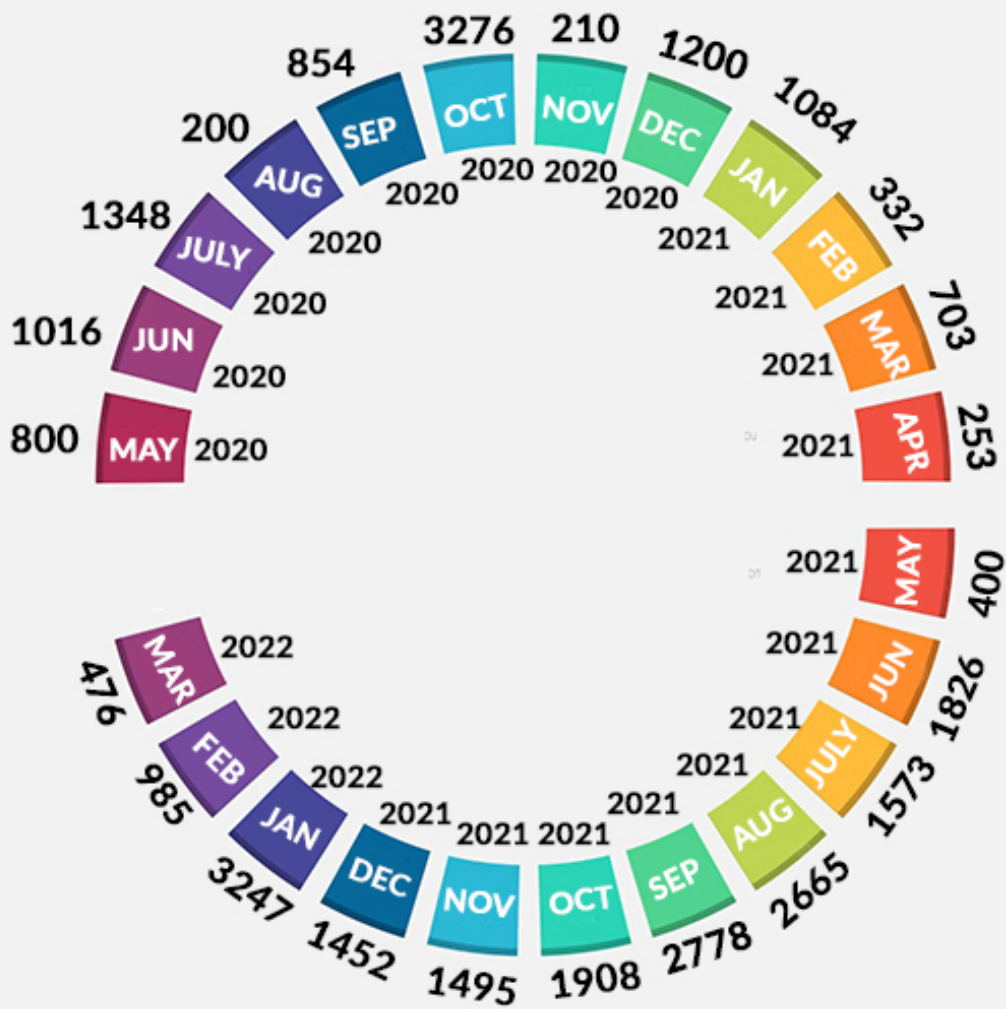

- Bereavement counselling

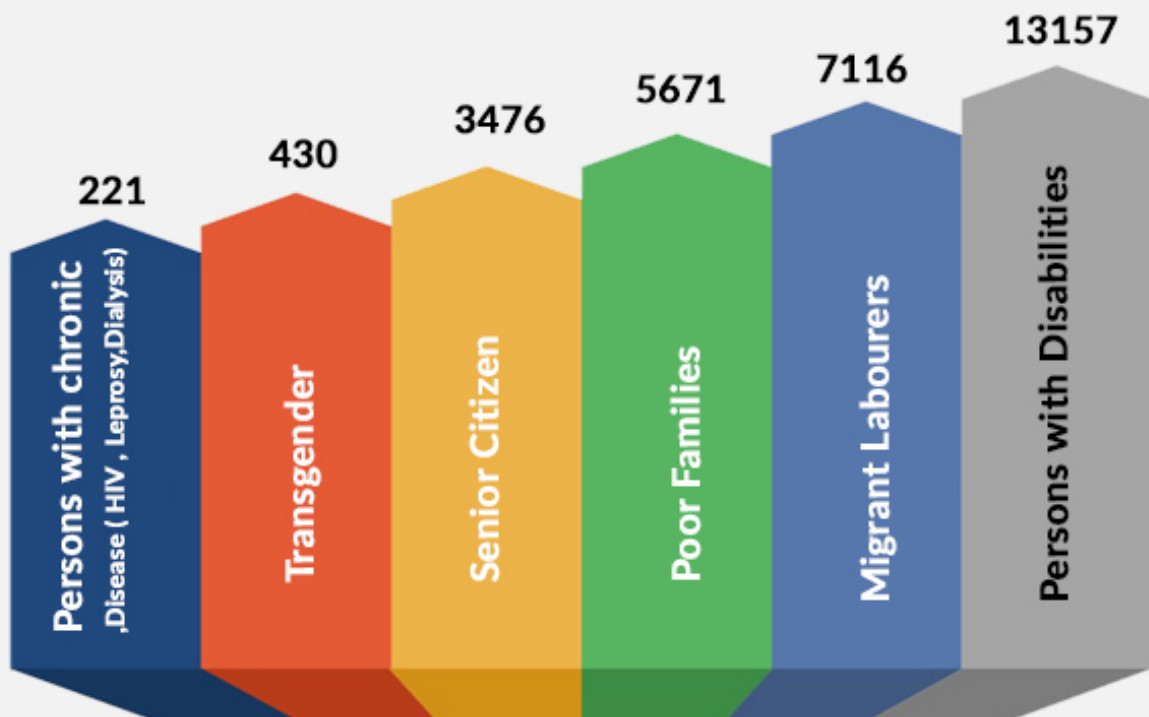
METHODS OF ASSISTANCE

Name of the Beneficiary: B. Anjaiah

Age: 44

Location: Karimnagar

Mr. B. Anjaiah lives in Karimnagar with his family and he lost his spouse Smt. Latha, during this Covid second wave. He has two daughters studying 7th & 4th Std., and the younger daughter Janani is a hearing impaired child. They are getting educated in a Govt. school in the rural village.

Soon after the Covid attack, his spouse passed away within 4 days. They had to struggle for mobilizing funds for the treatment and during hospitalization, incurred Rs. 60,000 plus. However, all the effort was futile and now he has to pay back all the loans taken from other sources at a higher rate of interest, in order to save his wife. He is a driver and dependent on the wages from driving car. He finds it challenging to maintain the family and at this crucial juncture Give India offered support by giving financial assistance to the tune of Rs. 30,000/-

He came to know about Ashray Akruti and its initiatives through one of his friends from Social Media.

We also humbly appeal to you to participate in this effort.
